Any member wishing to enrol in Judges Training Schemes for Agility, Endurance, Herding, Obedience, RAFT, Field Trials, Tracking or Track and Search should lodge an expression of interest with this office prior to 31 December 2011.

***Breeders are advised that, effective 01 January 2012, it is an ANKC requirement that all puppies are to be microchipped prior to registration.***

**Bookings for microchipping of puppies/dogs should be made at least 2 weeks in advance to ensure that the Association's volunteer implanters are available. All bookings should be made through the office.**

*The Westbury Agricultural Society has advised that the fee for camping at their grounds for the Western Tiers Kennel Club fixtures 26 – 29 January 2012 is \$10.00 per vehicle not \$10.00 per person.*

Agenda items for the ANKC National Obedience Conference should be submitted to this office including a rationale prior to 30 April 2012.

***The Kennel Club of Tasmania fixture that was scheduled in the Gazette to be held 12 February 2012 will not be going ahead.***

***The judges for the Ulverstone Kennel Club fixtures 04 (AM & PM) and 05 February 2012 have changed. Please contact the Event Manager for full details.***

The ANKC National Obedience Committee has given the following clarification on the CCD and Novice Re-call:

- The Handler is to wait for the judge to command the dog to sit.
- The deduction would be a minor for the dog failing to sit. It would also incur additional minor deductions for each additional time the dog does not sit.
- Give an additional deduction for the Handler not waiting for Judges' commands under 'Handlers Receiving Orders'.

### AGGRESSIVE DOGS

Members are reminded on TCA Inc Regulation 43, hereunder stated:

It is the obligation of any person at an activity who observes a dog behaving in an aggressive manner to report the incident either orally or in writing to a member of the Committee as soon as possible after the incident.

A new Clause has been included into the Association's Code of Ethics. They are listed below and are also incorporated into the Code of Ethics that is printed on page 41 of this Gazette.

As a member of the TCA Inc I will:

- Conduct myself politely and with integrity at TCA Inc approved events.
- Conduct myself in a sportsmanlike manner at such events and in any related activities or communications
- Respect the reputations of other members, including judges, at TCA Inc approved events and in dealings in wider forums, including chat lists, on the internet and in other communications.

# AMENDED/NEW REGULATIONS

## *Changes to existing Regulations are highlighted*

**22B** An entry for an official exhibition may not be accepted unless it includes the TCA Inc. membership number of the owner of the exhibit or the membership number issued by the relevant controlling body for an exhibitor not normally resident in Tasmania. The exhibitor or his agent entering a dog must complete and sign the entry form in ink, giving all details required for publication in the catalogue. The exhibitor or his agent shall be responsible for the correctness of the particulars on the entry form and shall be liable for the fees payable. An entry submitted on-line may be accepted by a club, however the Exhibitor's Declaration must be acknowledged by the person entering a dog on-line as a condition of the entry being processed. **Baby puppies below the age of six (6) months may be entered once the litter registration has been submitted to the office of the TCA Inc. They must be entered using the name applied for and in place of a registration number the words 'number pending'.**

**24** Each exhibitor making an entry for a Championship Show, shall supply a stamped self-addressed envelope for the return of number discs and a list of breed numbers entered at the exhibition. Each exhibitor making an entry for any other exhibition, shall supply a stamped self-addressed envelope in accordance with the schedule. **In the case of a championship show a breed list for each event shall be prepared with the total number of dogs in each group shown on the breed list.**

**24A** Where a club is using the same catalogue for more than one (1) event the (new) breed list for each event must be tallied at the end of each Group.

**91A** Where a penalty has been applied to a member or affiliate following a (new) disciplinary hearing the outcome will be published in the TCA Inc Gazette after the Appeal period has expired.

**107B** A TCA Inc registered breeder must not mate registered dogs of a different (new) breed (except where permitted under ANKC Regulations).

**109G** All puppies registered on the Main or Limited Register in the records of the TCA Inc must be microchipped. It is the responsibility of the breeders to ensure that puppies bred by them are microchipped with the details recorded on a recognised national animal registry database prior to supply/sale and the microchip number is recorded in the records of the TCA Inc. A Certificate of Registration and Pedigree will not be issued for puppies born after 01 October 2005 unless the Sire and Dam are microchipped. Exception may be given where the Sire is not microchipped and is registered by another member body or body recognised by the ANKC where microchipping is not compulsory.

**109I** All dogs must be registered in the Main Register or the Limited Register or the Associate Register or the Sporting Register of the TCA Inc prior to entry into any TCA Inc Sanctioned Event subject to Regulation 22B.

**111A** Any breeder who has either intentionally or unintentionally used multiple sires (new) over a bitch must, when applying to register the resultant litter, submit the following documents together with the appropriate Service Certificates and

Application for Registration:

DNA Test certificate in respect of each of the multiple sires used;

DNA Test certificate in respect of the Dam of the litter;

DNA Test certificates in respect of each puppy in the litter which are all required to be tested at the same time;

A certificate given by a Veterinary Surgeon providing an interpretation of the results of the DNA Tests as to the correct parentage of the litter.

Registration of the litter concerned will be processed based on the results provided in the Veterinary Certificate.

All costs associated with obtaining the certificates required are to be borne by the breeder of the litter.

**120** Any All Breeds Championship Show that exceeds eight (8) hours in any one (1) day, including meal times, shall be fined 2 units (as per the current 'Scale of Charges') for **the first** 15 minutes and 5 penalty units (as per the current 'Scale of Charges') for any subsequent 15 minutes, or part thereof, exceeding the time limit if in the opinion of the Council of the TCA Inc there were unnecessary delays.

**120A** In the case of an All Breeds Championship Show which has contracted two (2) (new) Judges or less and which exceeds eight (8) hours in accordance with Regulation 120 an additional penalty of \$500.00 will apply.

**155A** The Executive Officer may re-allocate a previously approved show date to another (new) Club where an affiliate is unable to conduct that event.

**188** Any dog not entered in the trial on that day, and used in an official capacity, must be checked by a club official prior to entering the trial ring.

**227** No dogs shall be transferred from one judge to another prior to the exhibition unless the entry is excessive or the scheduled judge is unable to meet the judging commitment. **An Affiliate must notify the TCA Inc** and also where possible in writing seven (7) days prior to the exhibition, all exhibitors affected by a change of judge. Where the judge announced in the schedule is altered, an exhibitor may withdraw from exhibition before commencement of judging by the substitute judge but shall not be entitled to a refund of entry fees.

**245** Stewards for Conformation and Obedience shall be persons approved by the TCA Inc. Council for listing on the official Stewards Panel. A contract shall be issued for each Steward officiating. Such contract shall be completed, signed and returned by the Steward in the stamped self- addressed envelope provided prior to the exhibition. An Affiliate is required to advise the TCA Inc. of any Steward who does not fulfil his/her contract. **Stewards (for conformation) may not Steward for Judges under whom dogs owned/handled by them are to be exhibited on that day.**

## OBEDIENCE TRIAL ETIQUETTE

If an entrant in an obedience trial wishes to withdraw at any stage, a reason must be given and permission obtained from the judge to withdraw. The judge is required to consider the effect on all handlers and dogs in the class and not act on imagined behaviour of a dog/s or handler/s. Because a dog has failed any earlier exercise is not an excuse to withdraw from any subsequent exercise including the stay/group exercises. Likewise, it is not permissible to withdraw because a handler thinks another dog in the class may upset his/her dog.

If a handler leaves the ring without permission from the judge a report may be made to the Council of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc.

# CANINE RESEARCH FOUNDATION

## RESEARCH GRANTS TO COMMENCE IN 2012

The Canine Research Foundation (CRF) is the research vehicle of ANKC Ltd. It is an independent Public Charitable Trust providing funds for research conducted at Australian universities and directed at improvement of canine health. Funds are generated via the levy on puppy registrations, fund raising functions, tax-deductible donations and bequests from the public. The CRF was founded by the VCA in 1992 and a total of over 80 research grants have been awarded to date. A selection of abstracts of past projects is available on the ANKC Ltd website, which demonstrates the quality of research being supported through CRF. You can be very proud of the contribution being made to improvement of canine health in Australia and internationally.

In the assessment of new applications for awarding of research grants, the review process has three stages: -

1. A review panel of top scientists and veterinarians to assess scientific merit and relevance to canine health.
2. A review by members of the ANKC Canine Health Committee for their input on relevance and importance.
3. A review by CRF Trustees to:
  - (a) ensure projects fit within the Foundation's Trust Deed
  - (b) award research grants to fit within available financial constraints and recommendations from the above reviews.

In the latest round of applications for research commencing in 2012, ten applications were received and four were awarded grants, with brief details of the successful applications given below.

### **Research Grants Awarded for Research Commencing in 2012**

1. **Title: *Coxiella burnetii* (Q fever): is this an important agent of disease in Australian dogs and reservoir for human infection?**  
(Dr Katrina Bosward, University of Sydney, \$14,050 for 2012)

The aims of the project are to:

1. develop a canine specific serological test for detection of antibodies to *C. burnetii* and compare the relevant methodologies based on cost, ease and accuracy;
2. determine the risk factors for dogs and humans.

Q fever is an important bacterial disease of animals and is transmittable to humans (zoonotic). It is considered one of the most common and serious of the zoonotic diseases. Given the 'flu-like' symptoms it is likely that the true impact in the community is underestimated. The role of *C. burnetii* in canine disease has not been clearly established. It is known that infected bitches have delivered dead puppies, with those surviving birth often dying soon after. Infection in humans can result in acute, chronic and subclinical disease, with a role in development of serious and occasionally fatal disease. Humans commonly acquire infection via inhalation of contaminated aerosols either directly from animals or indirectly via dust. A wide range of animals are considered important reservoirs for infection, the most frequently cited being production animals. While *C. burnetii* can be shed in large numbers in urine, faeces and milk, it is considered that the most potent are from birth products at parturition and milk of infected animals. A national vaccination program was instituted in Australia in 2001 and has successfully targeted workers in the meat and livestock industry; however recent studies have established that the relative importance of non-abattoir contact with livestock, wildlife or feral animals is increasing. There have been community outbreaks of Q fever in which dogs were established as the likely source of infection.

Confirming a diagnosis of Q fever is not straightforward. The researchers have already developed a serological test for feline *C. burnetii* infection in response to an outbreak in cats, and this line of approach is planned for infection in dogs.

**2. Title: Naturally occurring bacteriocins; a novel therapy for the treatment of multi-drug-resistant *E.coli* urinary tract infections in dogs.**

(Dr Justine Gibson, University of Queensland, \$12,900 for 2012)

Bacterial urinary tract infections (UTI) are common in dogs, and *E.coli* is the organism mostly frequently the cause. Many will be simple infections that are easily treated. Due to the rapid rise and spread of the multidrug-resistant (MDR) strains of *E. coli*, in both human and canine UTI, alternatives to conventional antimicrobial therapies are urgently needed. Bacteriocins provide an alternative solution. Bacteriocins are compounds produced by a variety of bacteria to inhibit the growth of closely related bacterial strains; they have a narrow killing spectrum and can be selected to target specific bacteria.

The aim of the project is to use bacteriological techniques to select bacteriocins that inhibit MDR *E. coli*, then identify the bacteriocin encoding gene. Once the target gene has been identified this can be cloned into a non-pathogenic *E. coli* for scaled-up production. Future research then will involve a mouse model investigating toxicity and half-life of the bacteriocin, and a bacteriocin protection study in mice with induced UTI prior to trials in a canine model.

**3. Title: Characterisation of an antibody directed at Canine Telomerase Reverse Transcription.**

(Dr Sam Long, University of Melbourne, \$4,515 for both 2012 and 2013)

Cancer represents one of the leading causes of death in older dogs. The spectrum of tumors that have been reported in dogs is remarkably similar to tumors seen in humans. With the development of treatments such as chemotherapy and radiotherapy, survival times for many tumors have steadily increased, however for some tumors survival is still only weeks or months. Increasing effort has been in developing therapies directed at novel targets, one of which is the enzyme telomerase. Telomeres are the non-coding regions at the ends of all mammalian chromosomes. Telomeres typically shorten with cell division, leading to aging and death of the cells. Telomerase acts to lengthen telomeres or prevent shortening, thus evading the pathways to aging and death of the cancer cells. Up to 90% of cancers in dogs so far examined contain telomerase. Telomerase has a component, telomerase reverse transcriptase (TERT), which catalyzes the lengthening of telomeres. Thus TERT has been proposed as a diagnostic and prognostic marker for a wide range of malignancies.

Only a few antibodies directed against telomerase have been developed and their specificities are under question. The aim of this project is to develop new antibodies specifically directed at detecting canine TERT to fully evaluate the presence of telomerase activity in canine tumors and to then develop telomerase-targeted therapies.

**4. Title: Structural and biochemical pathologies of canine epilepsy.**

(Dr Marjorie Milne, University of Melbourne, \$5,586 for both 2012 and 2013)

Epilepsy is a common condition amongst dogs. Of canine patients presenting at veterinary surgeries with seizures, approximately 38% are 'symptomatic' and have an identifiable cause and 48% are 'idiopathic' and have no identifiable cause.

In humans, the neurotransmitter glutamate has been shown to be an important factor in the generation of seizures. Recent work has indicated that humans with epilepsy caused by brain tumours have abnormally high levels of glutamate and increased presence of specific proteins that transport glutamate. Other research has shown that glutamate is transiently elevated in patients with seizures due to idiopathic epilepsy. High levels of glutamate and glutamate transporters were identified in brains of four dogs with familial epilepsy, and were associated with abnormal electrical activity that triggers seizures.

The aim is to investigate whether glutamate levels or the expression of glutamate transporter proteins are increased in patients with seizures as a result of brain tumours. The first stage of the project has been funded by a university grant. This application is to fund the second stage, which involves the characterisation of glutamate activity and transport in patients with both idiopathic and symptomatic epilepsy. Proposed methods are:

- (a) using high pressure liquid chromatography to evaluate glutamate levels in tumour tissue and the surrounding brain;
- (b) using molecular genetic techniques to study expression of glutamate transporter protein genes in the same tissues.

Similarly, Runner Up Best of Breed winners are not required by the Regulations to be exhibited for Runner Up Best in Group but may also do so at the option of the exhibitor.

- (B) The winners of a Best Exhibit in Group award or a Class in Group award are required to be exhibited in the judging of Best in Show or respective Class in Show and if such exhibit is not so exhibited all awards and prizes won by such dog in other classes at such Show shall be automatically cancelled. All cases in which, pursuant to this Regulation, an award or prize is cancelled, must be reported by the Show Committee to the TCA Inc within three working days of the conclusion of the Show. The

winner of a Runner-up in Group award which is not a Class in Group winner is not required by the Regulations to be exhibited in the judging of Runner-up in Show but may do so at the option of the exhibitor.'

## SHOW AND TRIAL REGULATIONS

All exhibitions conducted by the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc. and its affiliates are conducted under the rules and regulations of the Association, a copy of which may be inspected at the office of the secretary of the exhibition on the day of such exhibition.

The following rules/regulations apply to all exhibitions:

### **Financial Members:**

A person 18 years of age and over and who is a resident of Tasmania may not exhibit, handle, officiate in the judging ring or register an animal unless he/she is a current financial member of the TCA Inc. A person seven years and under the age of eighteen years who handles a dog in the judging ring is required to be a junior member of the TCA Inc. or a member of an affiliated club. At least one parent or guardian is required to be a financial member of the TCA Inc.

All dogs shall be entered for exhibition on the official cheque-book entry form and must have all details required for publication legibly completed thereon and in ink.

Entry fees must accompany the entry form and should be paid by cheque or money order (refer Australia Post regulation).

**A stamped, self-addressed envelope must be included for the return of number discs for championship shows, obedience and retrieving trials.**

### **Substitute Judges:**

The affiliate conducting an exhibition reserves the right to substitute judges if the committee deems it necessary. Entry fees are not refundable - refer TCA Inc Regulation 227.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her exhibit/s available for judging in all classes or events for which it is correctly entered and for the classes for which it subsequently becomes eligible - TCA Inc Regulation 33.

# TASMANIAN CONTEST OF CHAMPIONS REGULATIONS

1. This competition is organised by the Combined Breeds Dog Club of Tasmania Inc.
2. Any dog/bitch must have attained the title of Australian Champion by 31 December each year that is confirmed by the TCA Inc office prior to 15 January in the following year.
3. Each year the number of judges to be appointed shall be determined by the committee of the Combined Breeds Dog Club of Tasmania Inc.
4. The judges will be selected by the committee of the Combined Breeds Dog Club of Tasmania Inc and will be utilised the next day to officiate at an All Breeds Championship Show. The winner of the Contest of Champions will be excluded from exhibiting at this fixture.
5. For dogs/bitches to compete at the Contest of Champions all qualifying points must be obtained at Tasmanian shows.
6. Dogs/bitches must gain their wins in Tasmania but do not have to be owned outright by a resident of Tasmania. Dogs/bitches, at the time of qualifying, wholly owned by a person/s not resident in Tasmania are ineligible.
7. There will be 32 invitations issued to the top qualifying dogs on the following basis:
  - The top 4 dogs/bitches in each Group will be invited to compete.
  - The other 4 invitations will be determined by a wild card draw.Scoring for these positions will be as follows:  
Best in Group – 5 points and for every multiple of 25 exhibits over 50 another point is allocated.  
Runner Up Best in Group – half the number of points allocated to the Best in Group.
- If any dog/bitch invited cancels, withdraws or does not accept the invitation an invitation will be issued to the next highest scoring exhibit.
8. Invitations will be forwarded to exhibitors as soon as possible but no later than 15 January in each year.
9. Judging will be by means of a knock out competition, 16 heats with the winner of each heat going through to the next round until 2 only remain. There will be one final winner. The order of judging will be determined by a public draw at the event prior to the commencement of judging.
10. The TCA Inc Council will appoint an independent adjudicator for the event.
11. In the event of any contingency arising which is not covered by these Regulations the club's committee, in conjunction with the TCA Inc appointed adjudicator, has the power to make such rulings as they determine are in the best interests of the club and the continuing prestige of the event.

# CODE OF BEHAVIOUR AND ETHICS FOR RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP INCLUDING KEEPING, WELFARE BREEDING, SELLING AND DISPOSING OF DOGS FOR MEMBERS OF THE TASMANIAN CANINE ASSOCIATION INC.

**SECTION 1 – CODE OF BEHAVIOUR** As a member of the TCA Inc I will:

- Conduct myself politely and with integrity at TCA Inc approved events.
- Conduct myself in a sportsmanlike manner at such events and in any related activities or communications
- Respect the reputations of other members, including judges, at TCA Inc approved events and in dealings in wider forums, including chat lists, on the internet and in other communications.

## **SECTION 2 – COMPLIANCE WITH CODE OF ETHICS**

Each member, upon signing an application for membership or renewal of membership of the T.C.A. Inc, and being duly elected to general membership of the TCA Inc, shall, in addition to agreeing to be bound by the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of the TCA Inc, be also bound by the TCA Inc's Code of Ethics relating to responsible dog ownership, including the keeping, welfare, breeding, selling and disposing of dogs by members to the effect of the terms and conditions set out under Section 2 hereof.

## **SECTION 3 – CODE OF ETHICS AND UNDERTAKING**

In consideration of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc electing me to its general membership and approval of that renewal from time to time, I pledge to the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc that: -

1. I shall ensure that at all times all dogs under my control are properly housed, fed, watered, exercised and receive proper Veterinary attention, if and when required.
2. I shall not allow any dogs under my care to roam at large and when away from home ensure that they are kept fully leashed, or under effective control, at all times. All dogs must be able to stand up to full height and be able to turn around with ease in any crate in which it is confined.
3. I shall breed only for the purpose of improving the **quality and/or working ability of the breed in line with the breed standard** and not for the pet market or any other commercial purpose.
4. **I shall not breed from any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp before it is 12 months of age and I shall not breed any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp more than twice in any 18 month period. I will not breed any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp more than 6 times without prior written approval from the TCA Inc Council.**
5. I shall not permit any of my pure bred dogs to be mated to a dog of a different breed, to a cross-bred dog, or to an unregistered dog of the same breed.
6. I shall not sell or otherwise transfer from my care any puppy under 8 weeks of age, **within Australia and 11 weeks of age overseas, the pup must have had its initial vaccination for distemper and parvo-virus.**
7. I shall ensure that all persons acquiring dogs from me clearly understand their responsibility for the care and welfare of the animal, that they have the time and facilities (i.e. adequate fences, sufficient room and proper shelter etc) to perform their obligations.
8. I shall provide to all purchasers of dogs sold or placed by me, written details of all dietary and immunisation requirements and/or an appropriate publication relating to such requirements and responsible dog ownership.
9. I shall not sell any dog to commercial dog wholesalers, retail pet dealers, or directly or indirectly allow a dog to be given as a prize or donation in a contest of any kind.
10. I shall not knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of the breed, nor falsely advertise, or mislead any person regarding the performance of any dog.
11. I shall ensure when selling or transferring a dog to another person that documents as required by TCA Inc Regulation 58, will be provided to the purchaser or transferee.
12. I undertake not to advertise puppies for sale as TCA Inc registered until the application for registration has been lodged with the TCA Inc Office.

## **SECTION 4**

Any member failing to observe any provisions of the Code of Ethics may be dealt with under the Regulations of the TCA Inc.

## PUPPY OF THE YEAR RULES

### *Hosted by The Tasmanian Kennel Club Inc*

1. These rules, once approved, may not be changed unless with the written permission of Council and such permission shall be sought in adequate time to allow the revised rules to be published in the Tasmanian Canine Association's Gazette for the information of members.
2. The competition will be scheduled during the months of February and March in each year.
3. Invitations will be issued not later than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of the competition.
4. The **Puppy of the Year** Competition will be open to all dogs which have been entered in classes 2 (dogs) and 2a (bitches) and 3 (dogs) and 3a (bitches) which have been awarded a minor puppy or a puppy in group at an all breeds championship show or awarded a minor puppy or a puppy in group at a specialist group club championship show, conducted on or between 1st January and 31st December in any one year.
5. Dogs, which qualify, must be owned by a resident of Tasmania at the time of qualification and such owner/s or lessee/s must be a current member of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc.
6. A puppy, which has been awarded **Puppy of the Year**, will be ineligible to compete in any future **Puppy of the Year** competitions.
7. The responsibility of recording eligibility of dogs for competition shall rest with the affiliate conducting such an event. Such eligibility will be confirmed, on request, from the records of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc.

# THE CANINE EXHIBITION

## *A Show being held on 24th November 2012 to celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the first Australian Dog Show which was held in Hobart Town in 1862*

It is with regret I advise Terrier exhibitors that our previously advertised Judge for the 150th Anniversary Show, Peter Luyten from Victoria, has had to withdraw from all future judging appointments owing to ill health. We extend our good wishes to both he and his wife. We have been fortunate to obtain the services of Keith Lovell (Victoria) to fill this position on our judging panel. Well known around the world for his very successful Airedale Terriers. His Tjuringa Kennels are also home to Welsh Terriers. Keith has judged in many overseas countries and we welcome his acceptance to represent his home State on the panel and judge Terriers for us.

Heats for our 'Made in Tasmania' Competition will be held prior to the following shows (more Heats will follow in the later months) :-

The Heat will commence half an hour before the advertised show start (usually this will mean 8.30 a.m.)

It should be noted that each Heat is being conducted by this Canine Exhibition Committee and the results will have no bearing on that day's show results.

- Entry fee of \$10 per exhibit will apply and paid with entry to be taken by the Steward at ringside prior to entering the ring.
- Half of the entry fees collected will be apportioned between the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters at the final; this is to be held at the Canine Exhibition Show on Saturday 24th November 2012.
- The exhibit must be have been bred in Tasmania and aged between 6 months and under 24 months on the day the Heat is being judged.
- The exhibit must also have been entered in that day's Show and the exhibitor must use the exhibit number issued for that event in order to enter the Heat.
- Dogs and Bitches will be judged at the same time.
- The Heat judge will have All Breeds Championship status and will select two dogs from the line-up to compete in the final to be held on 24th November 2012.
- Sashes will be awarded to each of the Heat Qualifiers
- The Finals winner, in addition to the monies mentioned will be awarded a trophy, donated by his family, in memory of the late Tasmanian All Breeds Judge and T.C.A. President, Trevor Haas.

Our thanks go to the Judges and Clubs who have indicated their support for this competition.

Causing some interest here is a comment in the original show report that, when one of the dogs was requested to 'turn the whole show down the lane', it apparently tried its best to do so. This led to the reporter commenting that this exhibit must have been a real '**Smithfield Colley**' (nowadays Collie).

'Smithfield', at the time, was likely to have been a generic name applied to several types of large, heavy working dogs; used in south eastern England to drove cattle to the Smithfield Market in London. Contemporary writers described them as having a large square head and body, drop ears, length of coat and with many carrying the natural bob-tail gene. Several dogs of this type were exported to NSW where W. Beilby, writing in 1897, described them as being of an Old English Sheepdog type. Farm dogs of this general type are still found in Tasmania where their work on sheep as well as cattle is greatly appreciated. Efforts are being made here to establish recognisable breeding lines. However, at this time, the ANKC does not recognise a 'Smithfield' as being a separate breed. Two sheepdogs were entered in the first show but the bulk of the entries were for Gundogs and Terriers.

It is with a great deal of pleasure I advise that major sponsorship has been promised by Martin Pedersen of OKS Engineering. His Lightweight Showequipment is finding a great deal of favour in Tasmania and his donations and support are greatly appreciated.

Are you interested in advertising your business on Pay TV, Sky Channel, in The Mercury, Advocate and Examiner Newspapers, interstate papers, radio sports national as well as being listed at all Tote outlets and in the Hobart Greyhound Racing Guide? Well now is your chance. For a very reasonable donation you are able to access all these outlets at the one time. This Committee has been invited to sell naming rights to all the races at one of the HGRC nights next year. Other benefits also apply. There are ten races in total and any person interested is asked to contact me by phone to discuss the opportunities offered.
