SUMMARY OF THE ANKC CONFERENCE, MELBOURNE

17TH & 18TH OCTOBER, 2009

At the October 2009 ANKC Conference, the Delegates resolved/considered the following:

1. ANKC MAIN CONFERENCE

1.1 Election of President

At the recent conference of the Australian National Kennel Council held in Melbourne, Mr Hugh Gent OAM was re-elected President for a three year term from 1 January 2010.

1.2 Working Gundog Association of Australia

Delegates resolved to endorse the recommendation from the National Retrieving & Field Trial Committee for the ANKC to recognize the Working Gundog Association of Australia.

1.3 National Aggressive Behaviour Rule

Delegates resolved for a Working Party to be formed to prepare a report on implementing a national regulation on aggressive behaviour.

1.3 ANKC Regulations Part 6 - Amendments

Delegates resolved to amend Regulations Part 6 by removing Clauses 5.1.4 and 5.1.6 and to amend Clause 5.1.2 to read:

“5.1.2 – the dog is not to be exported without the permission of the owner/breeder who applied the restriction.”

Delegates resolved to amend Regulations Part 6 – 1.1 – Animal File to read:

“1.1 Animal File

Animal files will be made available nationally to any person or body who request them, but the names and addresses of the people associated with the information contained in the animal file will not be released. (11/93, 5.2)

If requested, information be supplied to Members on disk as follows:

- Dog's name, number, date of birth and colour to be the only information supplied (10/07, 7.12)
- When the facility is available, specialist reports would be charged on an individual basis depending upon time and workload.”

Delegates resolved to amend Regulations Part 6 Clause 10.1.11 to include the following wording at the end of the paragraph:

“subject to ANKC Regulation Part 6, Clause 10.2.1”.

Delegates resolved to amend Regulations 6 Clause 10.2.1 to read:

“Any new breed or breed of dog under development must have a unique breed name, and is not a combination of recognized breed names or part of a recognized breed name and it must be pertinent to the purpose of the breed”.

1.4 Litters – Syndicate Membership Signatures

It was resolved that in syndicate/partnership memberships, all parties must sign all transactions unless there is signatory authority held.

1.5 ANKC Rules for the Conduct of Utility Field Trials for Gundogs

It was resolved to adopt the amendments to the Rules for the Conduct of Utility Field Trials for Gundogs to be effective from 1 January 2010.

1.6 ANKC Committee/Working Parties

It was resolved that members of all ANKC sub committees, as a condition of their appointment, be required to sign confidentiality agreements and observe confidentiality in any discussions occurring within the subcommittee/s of which they are a member and not to disclose any details of those discussions to another outside party.

It was resolved that all ANKC Committees have a nominated Deputy Chairperson who will be appointed by the Committee at their first committee meeting.

1.7 ANKC Summary of Decisions

It was resolved that the publication of the Summary of Decisions post the annual conference be delayed until the minutes of the meeting have been ratified by all States.

1.8 New Championship Title for Neutered Dogs

It was resolved that a new Championship Title be implemented for Neutered dogs from 1 July, 2010. The title will be designated “Neutered Champion”.

1.9 Amendment to Uniform National Entry Forms

It was resolved that the certification statement on the uniform national entry forms be amended to read:

"I certify that this exhibit has not within the said period of three months been in kennels affected with Distemper, Canine Hepatitis, Parvo Virus or any other contagious disease and is currently vaccinated in accordance with current AVA vaccination policies."

1.10 Uniform National Trial Qualification Cards

It was resolved that the ANKC implement from 1 July, 2010 a uniform National Trials Qualification Cards for use in each trial discipline.

1.11 Minimum Breeding Age for Bitches

It was resolved for the ANKC to set minimum breeding ages for bitches of all breeds and for this matter to be referred to the ANKC Canine Health Committee for their recommendation.

1.12 Breed Standard Protocols for DNA Testing

Delegates resolved that the ANKC establish standard protocols for DNA testing and for this matter to be referred to the ANKC Canine Health Committee for their recommendation.

1.13 ANKC Regulations Part 2

Delegates resolved to amend Regulations Part 2 by renumbering Clause 1.5 to 1.8 and adding three new clauses 1.5, 1.6 and 1.7 as follows:

New Clause 1.5

1.5 The judge for each show must sign an Official ANKC Judges Contract where they are officiating. The contract must also be signed by an official of each club where the judge is officiating.

New Clause 1.6

1.6 A copy of the completed contract, as above, must accompany the Prize Schedule when it is submitted to the Member Body's office.

New Clause 1.7

1.7 Clauses 1.5 and 1.6 apply to all judges including non-resident judges.

Renumber Clause 1.5 to 1.8

1.8 The ANKC shall make available an official Judges Badge. (09/86)

1.14 ANKC Regulations Part 5

It was resolved that ANKC Regulation Part 5 Clause 1.5 be amended to read:

"1.5 Only entire dogs and bitches can compete in the Veteran Classes at Specialist and Semi-Specialist Show where the winners are eligible to compete for Challenge Certificates."

2. NATIONAL BREED STANDARDS COMMITTEE

2.1 Undocked Tail Descriptions - FCI and AKC Standards

Delegates endorsed that the ANKC adopt the recommendation that until the Italian Corso Dog, the Black Russian Terrier, the Cocker Spaniel (American) and the Australian Shepherd Dog standard include an Undocked Tail Description, the ANKC adopt the current Kennel Club (England) Undocked Tail Description for these four [4] breeds subject to consultation with the relevant overseas controlling bodies.

2.2 Undocked Tail Description – Old English Sheepdog & Boxer

Delegates resolved until the ANKC amends its policy regarding the continued adoption of Pre 1987 Kennel Club (England) standards, that the ANKC adopt the current Kennel Club (England) undocked tail description for those previously docked breed that have adopted the Pre 1987 Kennel Club (England) standard, the Old English Sheepdog and Boxer.

2.3 Kangal Dog and Anatolian Shepherd Dog

Delegates resolved that the ANKC try to resolve the situation with the Kangal Dog and the Anatolian Shepherd Dog by sending a letter to all registered Kangal Dog and Anatolian Shepherd Dog owners outlining the following:

6.1 The ANKC resolve to have all Kangal Dogs DNA tested to ascertain if it is a separate breed to the Anatolian Shepherd Dog. If the DNA test shows that the Kangal Dog and the Anatolian Shepherd Dog are the same breed, the ANKC resolve to declare that the Kangal Dog and the Anatolian Shepherd Dog are the same breed. All Kangal Dogs to be re-registered as Anatolian Shepherd Dog and recognised as a single breed (not even as two varieties of the same breed) and treated as a single from 1 January 2010. The standard for the breed, to be the current Anatolian Shepherd Dog standard.

6.2 The two breeds to remain as two [2] separate breeds. Should the DNA test show

significant differences between the two breeds, then the ANKC resolve to declare that the Kangal Dog and the Anatolian Shepherd Dog are two [2] separate breeds with no inter breeding between the two breeds. To resolve that a moratorium of five [5] years be declared before this policy can be reconsidered.

Kangal breeders are to be advised that failure to respond by 30 June 2010 may result in the Kangal Dog no longer being an ANKC recognised breed.

2.4 Moratorium on Breed Standard Extensions

Delegates resolved that a moratorium of 5 years be placed on the amendment of Breed Standard Extensions (BSE), except where the Breed Standard has been amended. Only those clauses of the BSE, directly affected by the Breed Standard amendment can be amended.

2.5 White Swiss Shepherd Dogs – Re-Registration of Imported Dogs

Delegates resolved that the current ANKC Policy in relation to the re-registration of imported White Swiss Shepherd Dogs be amended to remove the clauses which direct Member Bodies to verify that:

- “Imported White Swiss Shepherd Dogs MUST have all dogs in the background of their Import Certificate registered as White Swiss Shepherd Dogs in compliance with ANKC Regulation Part 6 Clause 3.4.
- If one or more of the dogs in the background of the Import Certificate is registered as a German Shepherd Dogs the dog cannot be registered on the ANKC Main or Limited Register.”

An application to re-register an imported dog must only comply with the current ANKC Regulations Part 6, Section 3.

2.6 Judges Rewarding Exaggerations in Breed Standards

It was resolved that Judges be directed to consider the original purpose for which a dog was bred and if necessary refer to the original standards at ring-side.

2.7 ANKC Policy on Adopting Breed Standards

It was resolved that the ANKC Policy on Adopting Breed Standards be amended to include that all previously docked breeds to have both docked and undocked tail descriptions in their standards.

2.8 Pre 1987 Kennel Club (England) Standards

With the present political climate and the world wide pressure towards eliminating exaggeration from breed standards it has been unanimously resolved to cancel the current ANKC Policy of allowing breeds to adopt the Pre 1987 Kennel Club (England) Standards and for the ANKC to adopt the current standard from the Kennel Club (England) or from the Country of Origin/Development. For those breeds who originally chose to adopt the Pre 1987 Standard the National Breed Council, Breed Clubs or Owners will be surveyed to choose between the current Kennel Club standard or the Country of Origin/Development standard.

3. NATIONAL BREED COUNCILS LIAISON COMMITTEE

3.2 ANKC Regulations Part 13

It was resolved to amend Regulations Part 13 Clause 4.2.5 as follows:

Where a National Show is held, no Challenge Certificates shall be awarded for the breed/s involved in the National Show, within a radius of 1000km from the show on that day/s.

The change to Regulations 13 Part 4.2.5 to be implemented from 1 March 2010.

It was resolved to amend Regulations Part 13 Clause 2.3.2 to read:

2.3.2 Where members of Breed Clubs cannot comply with the requirements of Clause 2.3.1 in that three (3) Specialist Breed Clubs, each affiliated with a separate Member Body of the ANKC do not exist, consideration will be given where two (2) Specialist Breed Clubs exist and members actively interested in the breed are represented by a “Breed type Multi-breed Club” i.e. “Setter Club”, “Spaniel Club” etc. (but not a Group Club) in at least one (1) other State or Territory. Membership of the two (2) Specialist Breed Clubs and the one (1) “Breed type multi-breed Clubs” will be sufficient qualification to apply for registration of a National Breed Council for the breed. The membership qualification will not be accepted unless all of the clubs are located in different States or Territories.

3.3 Rottweiler Breed Standard Extension – Tail Carriages

Delegates resolved for the ADRK Pictorial Explanations of acceptable and non acceptable tail carriages to be included in the ANKC Extended Rottweiler Breed Standard after relevant translation anomalies had been rectified.

3.4 Australian Canine Eye Scheme (ACES)

It was resolved for the ANKC to request for the provision on the ACES forms for examining Ophthalmologist to fill in their complete contact details, e.g., name, address & telephone number, as well as their signature.

4. NATIONAL SHOW JUDGES TRAINING COMMITTEE

4.1 Guidelines for Affiliates

It was resolved to adopt a set of Guidelines for Affiliates. These will be available from the ANKC website from January 2010.

4.2 ANKC Regulations Part 3

It was resolved to amend Regulations Part 3 Clause 1 by inserting a new sub clause 1.9:

1.9 Clerk of Examinations. A person approved by the ANKC Member body to oversee all aspects of the Practical Examinations.

It was resolved to amend Regulations Part 3 Clause 2.1 by inserting a new sub clause 2.1 (a):

2.1 **Self Education** Trainee Judges will be required to educate themselves to examination standards by studying Breed Standards, ANKC approved Breed Standard Extensions, the ANKC Glossary of Canine Terms and other appropriate material, researching breeds and presenting their findings, attending appropriate Lectures, Seminars and Field Events as arranged by the Member Body CJC, writing critiques, visiting kennels, discussing breeds with breeders and exhibitors, attending Group and Breed Championship Shows, thereby acquiring as wide and as sound a knowledge as possible of the breed, or breeds in the relevant Group. Education and Examinations will incorporate the principles of Competency Based Training and accreditation of Assessors.

(a) The competencies, which Trainees will be expected to achieve through the program are:

- Demonstrate a knowledge and understanding of the Breed Standards
- Ability to identify characteristics in relation to the Breeds for the Group in which they are a Trainee.
- Ability to recognise soundness in relation to the Breeds for the Group in which they are a Trainee.
- Ability to use Breed specific language and apply it correctly in their description of the Breeds for the Group in which they are a Trainee.
- Ability to approach and examine the exhibits correctly and appropriately for the Breeds for the Group in which they are a Trainee.
- Ability to place the better dogs at the front of the class in the Breeds for the Group in which they are a Trainee.
- Demonstrate control, organisation and effective use of the judging ring.
- Demonstrate an ability to make decisions in an effective way and in an efficient time frame.
- Demonstrate a practical knowledge of stewarding.
- Demonstrate an ability to understand and apply the Regulations relevant to dog judging.

It was resolved to amend Regulations Part 3 Section 11 by inserting a new sub clause 11.1 and for the remaining clauses to be renumbered accordingly:

11.1 There shall be only one (1) Practical Examination per group per calendar year.

It was resolved that Regulations Part 3 Clause 1.6 be amended to read:

ANKC Championship Show Judge. A person who has successfully completed the required Trainee Judge Theory and Practical Examinations is qualified to judge individual breeds and/or one or more Groups at Championship Shows conducted anywhere in Australia and Overseas.

4.3 Open Book Examinations – New Breeds

It was resolved that the practice of sending out Open Book Examinations on new breeds to licensed Judges is to be discontinued.

CANINE RESEARCH FOUNDATION

RESEARCH GRANTS TO COMMENCE IN 2010

The Canine Research Foundation (CRF) is the research vehicle of ANKC. It is a Public Charitable Trust providing funds for research conducted at Australian universities and directed at improvement of canine health. Funds are generated via the levy on puppy registrations, fund raising functions, tax-deductible donations and bequests from the public. The CRF was founded by the VCA in 1992 and a total of 76 research grants have been awarded to date.

In the assessment of new applications for awarding of research grants, the review process has three stages:-

1. A technical review panel to assess scientific merit and relevance to canine health
2. A review by Member Bodies' Canine Health Committees for their input on relevance
3. A review by CRF Trustees to:
 - (a) ensure projects fit within the Foundation's Trust Deed
 - (b) award research grants to fit within available financial constraints and recommendations from the above reviews.

In the latest round of applications for research commencing in 2010, twenty applications were received and five were awarded grants, with brief details of the successful applications given below.

Research Grants Awarded for Research Commencing in 2010

1. Methods to reduce the severity and frequency of surgical infection.

Investigator: Prof. Ted Whittam, University of Melbourne.

Grant: \$12,000 total for 2010/2011.

The cost of surgical procedures is a considerable impost on pet ownership. Complications from this surgery due to surgical site infections (SSI) are usually unbudgeted additional pet-owner expense. As factors which predict the likelihood of SSI are identified, steps can be taken which will reduce postoperative wound infections.

This study aims to determine the incidence of and describe the factors associated with the incidence of SSI that occur in dogs undergoing surgery in a teaching and referral veterinary hospital in Australia. The study further aims to evaluate some specific strategies aimed to reduce the incidence and severity of SSI.

2. Loss of heterozygosity from chromosome 5 in canine oligodendrogliomas.

Investigator: Dr. Sam Long, University of Melbourne.

Grant: \$6,500 total for 2010/2011.

The spectrum of tumours seen in dogs is remarkably similar to that reported in people. Of the primary brain tumours seen, oligodendrogliomas comprise the third most common type. The mainstay of treatment in dogs currently comprises surgical debulking followed by irradiation.

However, surgical removal of tumours is associated with up to 19% of dogs dying either during surgery or in the immediate post-operative period, and radiation therapy is currently limited in availability in Australia.

The use of chemotherapeutic agents, either alone or in combination with other modalities would be beneficial in avoiding these problems. Given the loss of heterozygosity and sensitivity to chemotherapeutic agents in humans, the equivalent loss in canine oligodendrogliomas may also predict chemo sensitivity, allowing these tumours to be treated by non-invasive chemotherapeutic protocols, thus improving survival for dogs suffering from these debilitating tumours.

3. Measurement of faecal cytokines in healthy and diarrhoeic dogs.

Investigator: Dr. Mansfield, Murdoch University.

Grant: \$11,374 total for 2010/2011.

Cytokines are proteins produced in the face of inflammation, and are very important in mucosal surfaces such as the gastrointestinal tract. They are able to generate many other inflammatory mediators and are often the inciting factor for ongoing inflammation.

Measurement of faecal cytokines may become an objective way to assess response to treatment and monitor individual animals. This would be preferable to invasive diagnostic testing such as endoscopy or surgical biopsies.

4. Finding glaucoma genes in the canine.

Investigator: A/Prof. Baird, University of Melbourne.

Grant: \$10,881 for 2010.

Primary or inherited glaucoma is one of the leading causes of irreversible blindness in purebred dogs. Overall the prevalence of primary glaucoma is estimated to be nearly 1% across all dog breeds, but as high as 4-5% in the American Cocker Spaniel, Basset Hound and Chow Chow, and more than 1% across 19 other breeds. One of the major symptoms of canine glaucoma is an increase in intraocular pressure, which can rapidly cause blindness and is painful for the dog. Other symptoms include red, hazy eyes and dilated pupils.

The aim of this project is to use genes already associated with glaucoma in humans and assess their involvement in the canine species. By gaining direct evidence of involvement of these genes we can improve management of breeding practices and lead to eradication of the disease.

5. Assessment of lidocaine as an adjunctive analgesic after abdominal surgery in dogs.

Investigator: Dr. Sarah Haldane, University of Melbourne)

If lidocaine is shown to have the same effects in dogs as it does in people and horses with regards to analgesic effects, anti-inflammatory activity and improved gastrointestinal function in the post-operative period, it will be of immense benefit to small animal veterinary practitioners, as lidocaine infusion is both inexpensive and easy to administer. This drug may reduce the requirement for high doses of opioids that can reduce intestinal motility as well as causing sedation. It may also reduce the requirement for antiemetic or pro-kinetic agents post-operatively. There may even be an additional benefit in reducing time spent in hospital, both for dogs and for their owners in terms of quality of recovery and reduced expense veterinary care.

Research expenditure for 2010

Including the projects continuing from 2009, research expenditure provided for 2010 under the Foundation's grants will total \$118,345.

Donations and Bequests

Research grants are always limited by availability of funds, so that worthwhile projects may miss out. Breed clubs/councils and individual persons wishing to assist in this important research directed at improvement of canine health are invited to do so via donations or bequests. If they so desire, they may nominate a new or existing research topic related to their breed to receive the funding. Initial contact should be with the ANKC Administrator who will put you in touch with an appropriate person for discussion regarding the prospect.

Research Topics

The CRF is always keen to receive input of suggested research topics for referral to universities as the basis of research grant applications. Breed clubs/councils are invited to nominate research topics and forward them in writing to the ANKC Administrator for consideration by March 31 each year.

Thanks

The Trustees are confident that the resultant research will contribute significantly to improvement in canine health, and commend the ANKC Member Bodies, their breeders and other donors for the financial contributions and general support. Special thanks are due to those who give their time and effort to make the research program so successful.

Regular progress reports and final reports are received relating to CRF research grants and results of successful projects are published in veterinary journals as appropriate. Members can be very proud of the contribution being made to improvement of canine health.

CODE OF ETHICS OF RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP INCLUDING KEEPING, WELFARE BREEDING, SELLING AND DISPOSING OF DOGS BY MEMBERS OF THE TASMANIAN CANINE ASSOCIATION INC.

SECTION 1 – COMPLIANCE WITH CODE OF ETHICS

Each member, upon signing an application for membership or renewal of membership of the T.C.A. Inc, and being duly elected to general membership of the T.C.A. Inc, shall, in addition to agreeing to be bound by the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of the T.C.A. Inc, be also bound by the T.C.A. Inc's Code of Ethics relating to responsible dog ownership, including the keeping, welfare, breeding, selling and disposing of dogs by members to the effect of the terms and conditions set out under Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2 – CODE OF ETHICS AND UNDERTAKING

In consideration of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc electing me to its general membership and approval of that renewal from time to time, I pledge to the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc that: -

1. I shall ensure that at all times all dogs under my control are properly housed, fed, watered, exercised and receive proper Veterinary attention, if and when required.
2. I shall not allow any dogs under my care to roam at large and when away from home ensure that they are kept fully leashed, or under effective control, at all times. All dogs must be able to stand up to full height and be able to turn around with ease in any crate in which it is confined.
3. I shall breed only for the purpose of improving the **quality and/or working ability of the breed in line with the breed standard** and not for the pet market or any other commercial purpose.
4. **I shall not breed from any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp before it is 12 months of age and I shall not breed any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp more than twice in any 18 month period. I will not breed any bitch kept by me causing it to whelp more than 6 times without prior written approval from the TCA Inc Council.**
5. I shall not permit any of my pure bred dogs to be mated to a dog of a different breed, to a cross-bred dog, or to an unregistered dog of the same breed.
6. I shall not sell or otherwise transfer from my care any puppy under 8 weeks of age, **within Australia and 11 weeks of age overseas, the pup must have had its initial vaccination for distemper and parvo-virus.**
7. I shall ensure that all persons acquiring dogs from me clearly understand their responsibility for the care and welfare of the animal, that they have the time and facilities (i.e. adequate fences, sufficient room and proper shelter etc) to perform their obligations.
8. I shall provide to all purchasers of dogs sold or placed by me, written details of all dietary and immunisation requirements and/or an appropriate publication relating to such requirements and responsible dog ownership.
9. I shall not sell any dog to commercial dog wholesalers, retail pet dealers, or directly or indirectly allow a dog to be given as a prize or donation in a contest of any kind.
10. I shall not knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of the breed, nor falsely advertise, or mislead any person regarding the performance of any dog.
11. I shall ensure when selling or transferring a dog to another person that documents as required by T.C.A. Inc Regulation 58, will be provided to the purchaser or transferee.
12. I undertake not to advertise puppies for sale as T.C.A. Inc registered until the application for registration has been lodged with the T.C.A. Inc Office.

SECTION 3

Any member failing to observe any provisions of the Code of Ethics may be dealt with under the Regulations of the T.C.A. Inc.
